# Andregg Geomatics

## *We Put Your Project On The Map*

**B**ack in 1946, when Norm Andregg started his firm, surveyors used levels, plumb bobs and chains to determine property lines and building sites.

Today their profession is likely to be called geomatics, and it relies on modern GPS, high-definition laser scanning, satellites and other very high-tech devices to collect, interpret and report geographical data.

Headquartered in Auburn, Andregg Geomatics has grown along with the discipline. The firm is co-owned by Dennis Meyer (President) who bought the company from its founder in the 1970s and Mark Bardakjian (COO). Its staff still concentrates on land surveying, construction staking, mapping and geomatics, albeit with the latest methods and equipment and the addition of another specialty --land planning.

According to Annie Mager, Director of Marketing, a couple of years ago Andregg assessed the marketplace and decided to focus on the projects of the future: "water, rail, air and energy."

"We could see that there would be a lot of interest and need for projects relating to those areas," Annie said. "We wanted to put our expertise to work on public works and other projects that will propel us through the 21st century," she said.

Planning manager Jack Remington

signed on to the company about two years ago after closing his own engineering firm. "Jack's engineering expertise has allowed us to be involved in more projects. He can assist our clients in laying out and designing projects as well as processing them through the various agencies for approval," Annie said.

Recently named in the Business Journal's Top 25 list of engineering firms (and the only surveying firm on the list), Andregg's business focus is turning out to be a good call. The company is putting its expertise to work on several, mainly public works, projects throughout the Western U.S.

One big job is surveying and mapping for the Bradley West International Terminal expansion at the Los Angeles International Airport. Construction package 1 is now underway for the LEED Silver Certified terminal, with more phases planned throughout the decade.

Andregg was also on the survey team for the Oakland freeway maze repair

and is working with Sacramento Transit authorities on a new light rail leg to the airport. The "Big Build" project to expand Sacramento International Airport is another Andregg project, along with a wind energy project for SMUD and projects for the US Forest Service and USDA.

Once the project receives the go ahead, Andregg Geomatics is usually the first contractor to arrive. "We are there from the beginning to do the construction staking for water and sewer pipelines and transmission lines," Jack said.

To keep up with its many projects, Andregg now has offices in Fairfield, Reno, Truckee and project offices at LAX and the Sacramento airport. Company headquarters is at the beautiful Creekside Business Park in Auburn.
